


From the newest of RC hobbyist to the most experienced RC pilot this quick read offers us all a friendly reminder how to properly dispose of your LIPO battery after it's been damaged or been deemed bad for whatever reason.

What will you do with your LIPO battery after a crash and battery shows signs of physical damage, over discharging, swelling, puffing or any other reason battery may be deemed bad?

Quickest solution is to drop the defective battery off at Lowes or Home Depot into their battery recycling metal bin. That's it, you're done!



Secondly you can discharge LIPO battery and dispose with your normal household trash. This solution takes a little more effort but still an easy way to safely dispose of any LIPO battery. (youtube.com has several good videos on "HOW TO" properly discharge LIPO battery if needed or contact a club member.)



Last couple thoughts...

If your LIPO battery pack is visibly damaged, it is recommend discontinuing use, even if it is still holding voltage. The internal components are likely compromised. One more hard hit (or even just charging) could be the final straw that causes the battery pack to short out and cause a potential fire.

Whatever you choose to do PLEASE never dispose of a LIPO battery that still has a charge of any kind into the trash. The battery can short out and cause a fire potentially causing damage to someone or something.
