President's Notes

Rain again during a meeting night. It would have been nice to finish the summer meetings at the field, but mother nature had other plans. We will be back to the church now for meetings until next spring.

I discussed the club receiving its FRIA approval at the end of last month. We are now good until August of 2027 before it must be renewed. This will be an automatic process handled by the AMA. As stated in last month's newsletter, we do not need any remote id modules to fly at our field.

An update on the FRIA process, the FAA has extended the compliance time for 6 months to March 16, 2024. The reason for the shift is the lack of remote ID units and cost. In addition to that they underestimated the amount of work they must complete to issue FRIA approvals. A copy of the rules change can be found on the FAA website if you are interested.

Our Scale Aviation Day on September 2nd was successful. We had 16 pilots in attendance and multiple flights were flown. We also had quite a few visitors who stopped by to watch the flying and look the planes over. A big thank you to Kip for supplying the smoked hamburgers and to Mike who helped with set up, tear down, meal prep and football broadcasts. Everyone had a great time. Pictures from the event are posted on the club forum.

By the time you read this the new storage container should be in place at the field. We were able to find a 40 ft unit in pretty good condition. Everything stored in the white mower shed will be moved into it and plans are being made to remove the white shed. As we previously discussed, the new mower will be sourced in the spring.

We will be having a Hot Dog burn/ Fun Fly on October 7th. Bring out your planes, get some flights in, eat some hot dogs, and visit with your friends.

We have scheduled the night fly for October 14th. The sunset is at 6:57 that night so we won't have to wait long for it to get good and dark. We have had quite a few people ask about this so get your planes ready and batteries charged. If you haven't tried it before, it is a lot of fun.

Changes to the Bylaws were discussed. Moving the club fiscal year from Jan – Dec to Mar- April was discussed again and will be brought up for a vote by the membership at the next club meeting. The plan would be for everyone who is a member this year to receive the 3 months at the beginning of 2024 free while we change to the new dues rotation. Early dues payment will move from the current October timeframe to January.

I brought forward an additional change request to the bylaws concerning voting past members back into the club. For those who don't remember or weren't members at the time, this was implemented when the club was experiencing problems with noise complaints and people not abiding by the club bylaws. The proposal is to remove the first line in Article II Section 7 which states "Any lapse in membership status will require a board review and membership vote before the member is reinstated."

2024 elections are just around the corner. If anyone is interested in becoming a board member or has questions about being a board member, just ask. As Tyler has stated in his past newsletter articles, he is looking at stepping back due to other commitments, so there is at least one open position.

If you haven't already, check out the latest edition of Model Aviation. On page 106 in District VIII news the club managed to get a mention.

Fellow Westside Members, here's my take on Westside's field maintenance for September!

- ***Mowing Schedules***

Thanks to all members that have volunteered to mow for the '23 season. Team members, feel free to contact me if there's a conflict with the dates listed on the current mowing schedule. If you originally selected to not mow this season and have had a change of heart, please contact me and we can also use a spare mowing team member.

- ***WSRC Field Equipment***

The club's field equipment is in pretty good shape so now we just need to keep up the minor items of maintaining the correct fluid levels.

- ***Mower Shed***

We have put a band aid on the existing buildings dragging entry door, hopefully the new club Conex will be delivered within a few weeks so we can get started moving field equipment from the old white doghouse to the newer structure.

- ***Field Repairs Phase III***

We had a smaller turnout on the 16th than our previous field work party but were still able to get several projects completed. There was a mowing team, another team working on painting and installing steel protection grids on (5) of the pilot stations while additional work was completed on the remaining 6th station. The composite wood has been ordered and is scheduled to arrive between October 6th – 9th. Once it arrives the tops will be cut and installed. Another project at hand is the rebuilding of the remaining grandstand, Mike was at the field on Friday the 15th removing dilapidated wood pieces from previous work.

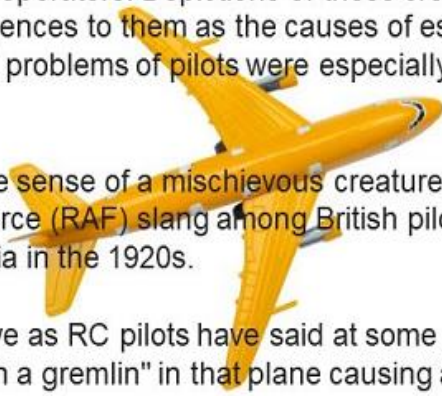
Eye Sight and RC Flying Go Hand in Hand...
