
**Fellow Westside Members, here's my take on Westside's field maintenance for October 2023!**

# TRICK OR TREAT

## Safety Tips

- 

1 Cross the street at corners, using traffic signals and crosswalks. Look left, right and left again when crossing and keep looking as you cross.
- 

2 Carry a FLASHLIGHT or a Glow Stick. WALK, Don't RUN!
- 

3 Wear clothing that has reflective markings or tape so you can be seen at night.
- 

4 Make sure costumes and shoes are the correct size to prevent tripping. If possible, use face paint and leave the mask at home since masks can obstruct vision.
- 

5 Inspect commercially wrapped treats for signs of tampering, such as an unusual appearance or discoloration, or tears in wrappers. Throw away anything that looks suspicious.
