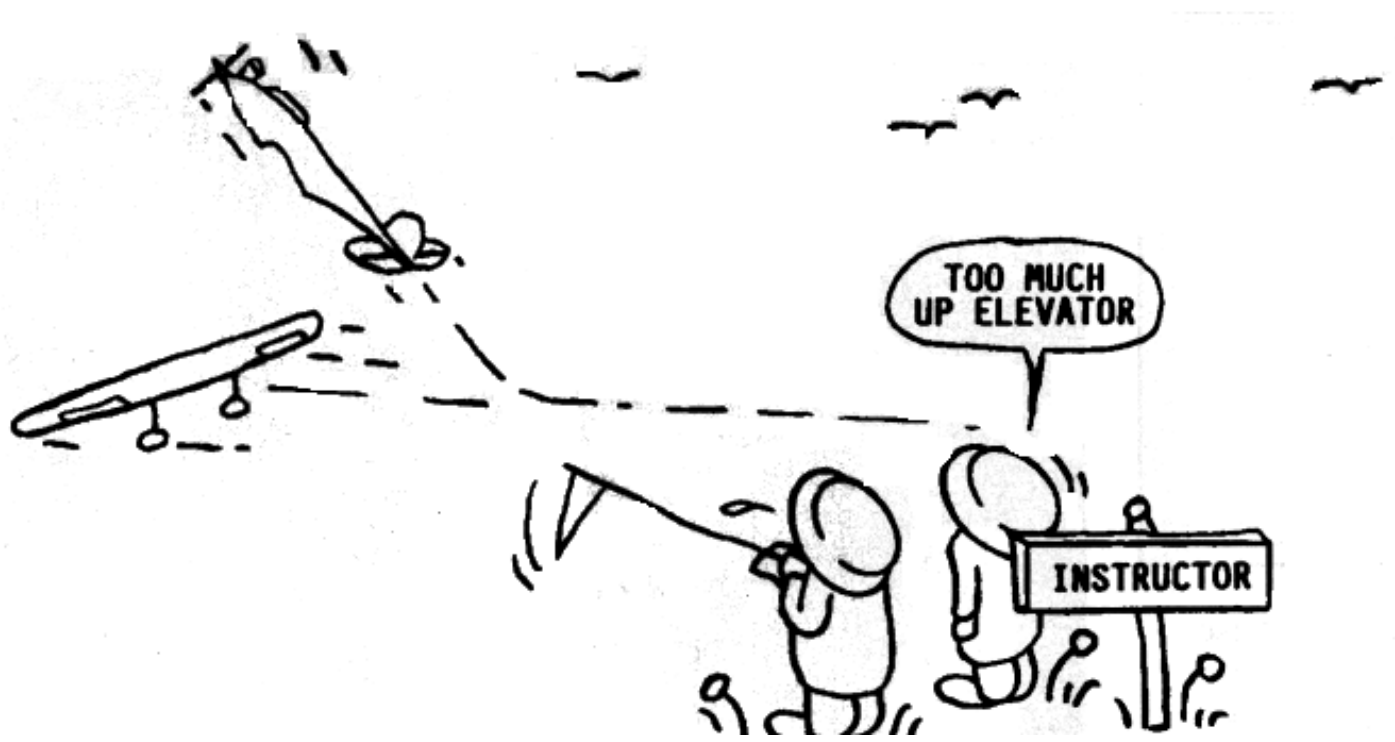

At least it was straight down the runway. Some flying was accomplished, hot dogs, chips and brownies were consumed. It was a good time.



In May we then participated in the Yukon Festival of the Child. The club used two flight simulators for kids to try their hand at R/C flying and we had a static display to show them what different types of planes we fly. We ended up having over 80 kids fly the sims, quite a few were pretty good. This was a good outreach for the club, and we will be attending it again in 2024.



On June 15th the city reached out again and asked if we could have a booth at their Route 66 Movie night event. We had simulators and a static display for the attendees to fly. When the sun went down, they showed Top Gun Maverick on a big outdoor screen.

The flying site located at/near 420 W Wagner Rd that you submitted on behalf of Westside RC Flyers Inc. has been approved as a FAA Recognized Identification Area (FRIA). This designation will satisfy the remote ID requirement for anyone flying at your club's site beginning September 16, 2023.

September 2nd was Scale Aviation Day. We had 16 pilots and multiple aircraft participating. Everything from WWI to modern day jets were flown. The weather was nice and sunny with winds straight down the runway (a little on the brisk side at times). A great lunch of Kip's special burgers was enjoyed by all. All in all, a very nice event.



At long last on September 29th, the Conex storage container was delivered to the field. This is a huge improvement for storing our equipment at the field and will allow us to get a bigger mower this coming spring.
