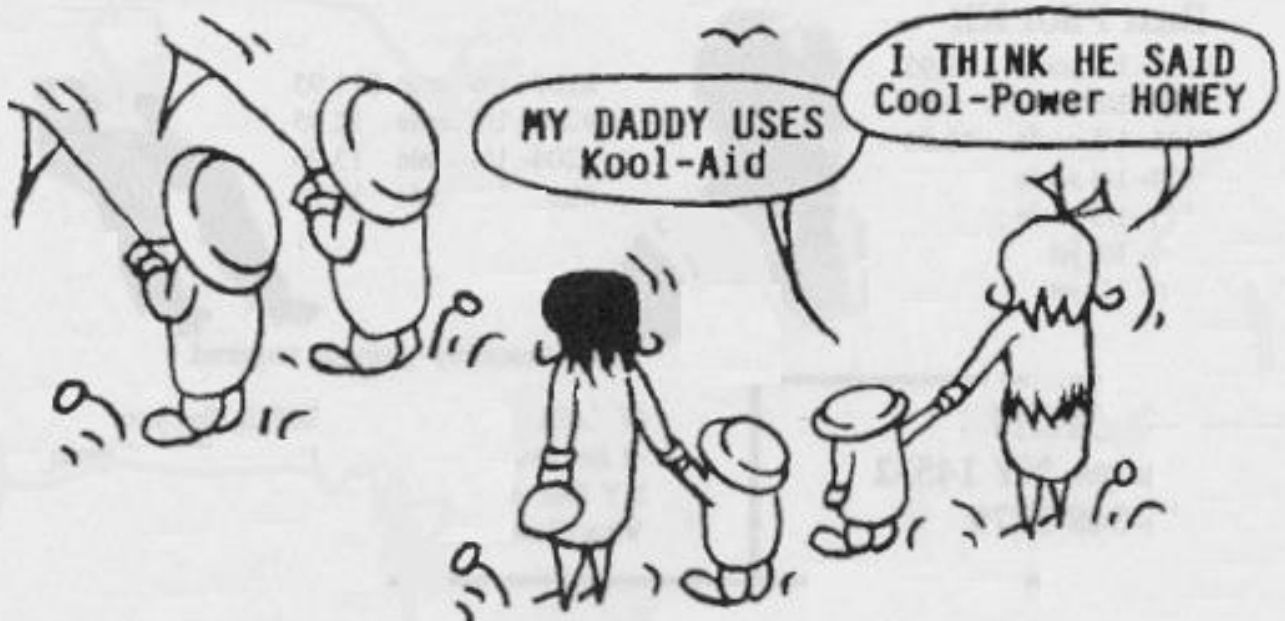

Additionally I found on Facebook Oklahoma RC Swap and Buy page, some interesting items in there or a chance to sell your stuff.

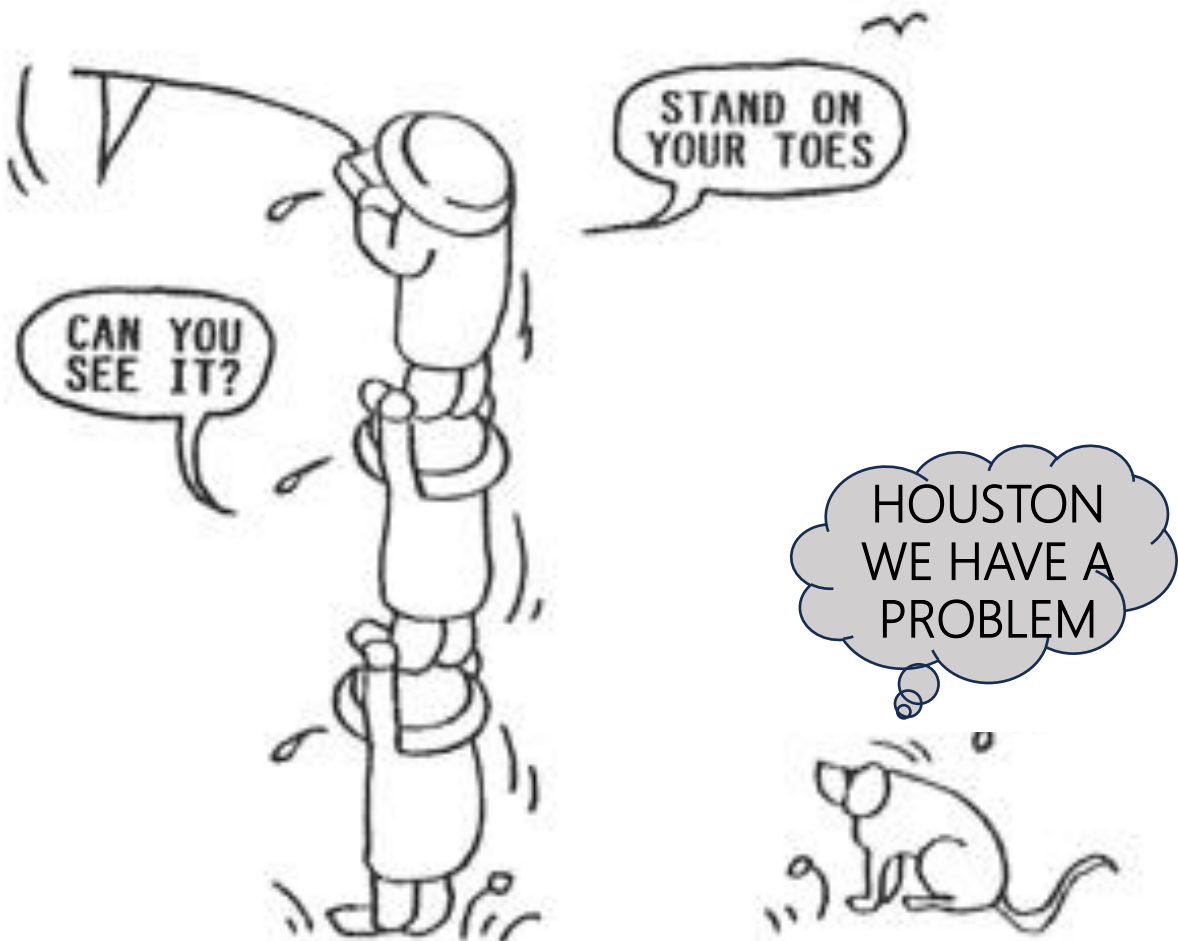
From the Treasurer

- 3.- Cost: \$5.00
- 4.- 3-year registration, then you'll need to update your registration again after three years.

2. TRUST Test ... [The Recreational UAS Safety Test \(TRUST\) | Federal Aviation Administration \(faa.gov\)](#)

- If you haven't taken the TRUST test its quick and easy to pass and also required by the FAA

3. Reminder to place club membership cards in the radio control box station if you are flying. THANK YOU to the ones that always take time to open up the frequency control box if you are the first person at the field.

Let's build a Racer!!

Since we are having a build night, I want give you a list of items you will need to get your racer started.

Here are links to plans you can download for both of the aircraft we will be racing.

2 20 x 30 foam board from Dollar Tree **NOTE:** you want to use the Dollar Tree foam, it is lighter than other foam and that will affect your planes performance.

High temp hot glue gun (if you have one)

High temp glue

A copy of plans for the plane you want to build

Tape

Pencil or pen

Exacto knife with blades or disposable breakaway blade razor knife

Cutting mat (if you have one)

Metal yardstick or ruler (if you have one)

At least one of the servos you plan on using for sizing holes (if you have one)

As a reminder, here is the list of the components needed for the planes.

Motor 2212 1400kv

Propeller 8x4e

Battery 3 cell 1800mah to 2200mah

Servos any 9g to 12g servo

ESC any 20 amp or more you want. System tests at approximately 190 watts.
